Thank you for your interest in *Women in Art*. We are a newly formed group whose mission is to promote the imaginative, artistic talent of women of the Southern Appalachian region. We are seeking professional female artists of all mediums who not only demonstrate superior skill, but are well established in the arts.

The intent of WIA is not to teach new craftswomen how to become successful in the business, but rather a vehicle for members to exhibit alongside other professionals, share experiences, marketing tips, professional affiliations, material resources, business and promotional contacts, and a love of the arts. By limiting the number of artists to 2-3 per medium, our artists will not be in competition with each other, providing a relaxed, friendly atmosphere to share and grow.

Although the group has a committee that is responsible for the organization and business aspects of the group, all members have a voice and play a vital role in its function. We ask each member to participate by suggesting venues where the group can exhibit, present marketing and promotional leads, share workshop and "call to artists" information, attend an annual meeting, and represent the group in a professional manner. Our members are scattered across several states, so most communications will be made through email, website announcements and phone calls.

As a collective group, we will be strong and our artistic voice will be heard. Our website will host a gallery section for our artists, providing space for everyone to display a sampling of their work, contact information and personal website link/addresses. There will be a member's only section where business and show information will be posted. The website is well underway and should be complete by early summer. (www.WomenInArt.org)
